



BARCIA AND PLESSINGER OVERCOME ADVERSITY AT ARLINGTON, TEXAS SUPERCROSS TO EACH TAKE A TOP 10 FINISH IN THE 450 CLASS AND JUSTIN COOPER SCORES SECOND PLACE IN 250SX

Monster Energy® Yamaha Factory Racing Team's Justin Barcia and Aaron Plessinger once again finished inside the top 10 with their YZ450F™'s to score Monster Energy® AMA® Supercross Championship points at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas.

Barcia got a good jump on the start in the main however his outside starting position wasn't ideal and the Floridian ended up in the hay bales. Never one to give up, the team's veteran rider charged his way from last to finish seventh. Barcia's rookie teammate had some challenges of his own as Plessinger got pinched off on the start, but put in the laps to ultimately finish ninth. Barcia now sits in sixth position in the standings with 104 points while Plessinger sits in 10th with 93.



In the 250 class, Justin Cooper kept his momentum rolling making another appearance on the podium, this time with a second place finish at the second round of the Monster Energy® AMA® Supercross 250SX East Championship, while teammate Mitchell Oldenburg took another solid sixth-place finish to score valuable championship points. Cooper sits in second in the 250SX East Championship with 44 points while Oldenburg lies sixth with 34
